Are you sure you want to Sign Out? To cancel, simply use the "Back" button on your browser to return to the previous page.

When you entered your user name and password earlier, you 'signed in.' This allowed you to view subscriber-only content.

Signing Out removes your Sign In information from your computer. The next time you access content in BMJ Journals Online, you will need to re-enter your User Name and Password, even if you selected "Auto Sign In" on the Sign In page.
